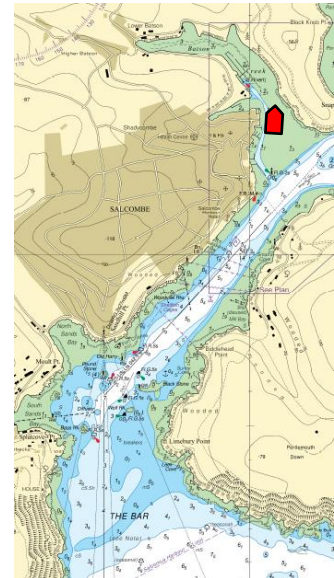
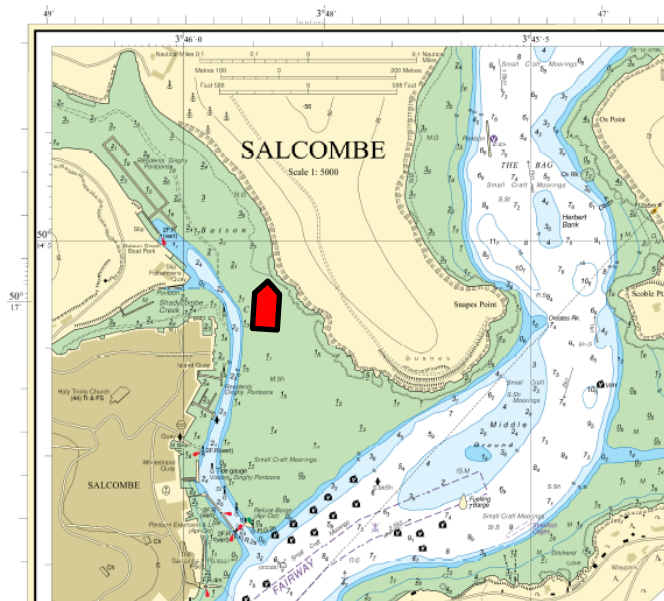
LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO 12 OF 2024



“FV EMMA JANE AGROUND” 02nd July 2024

Fishing Vessel “FV EMMA JANE” ran aground at approximately 05.00 on 2nd July 2024 tidal height at time of grounding was approximately 3.8 metres.

Location of the vessel is: Latitude: 50.239706 Longitude: -3.764448



Please be aware that the navigation channel from Batson is still currently open, however please give the area around the grounded vessel a wide berth when passing and do not linger in the vicinity.

Members of SHA staff are afloat alongside the vessel to monitor her status.

We are aware of the potential pollution risk associated with this incident and have prepared our equipment as well as notifying our Tier 2 Pollution Control Contractor.

In the event of the vessel falling into the channel we will be closing the navigation channel around the vessel to facilitate counter pollution measures and will update this Notice to Mariners in due course.

We are hopeful that the rising tide will refloat the vessel at approximately 14.00 to 15.00 this evening.
